1. You are assigned to Shipment 8884\* as Crew No. 8884\*-8, and to B-24 airplane number 41-29388, on aircraft project number 92415. You are equipped in accordance with the provisions of the movement order.
2. You are relieved from atchd, 6th Heavy Bomb Proc Hq, this station, and WP via mil aeft and/or rail to Morrison Field, Florida, or such other Air Port of Embarkation as the CG, ATC, may direct, thence to the overseas destination of Shipment 8884\*. Upon arrival at the Air Port of Embarkation, control of personnel is relinquished to the CG, ATC.
3. This is a PERMANENT change of station. You will not be accompanied by dependents; neither will you be joined by dependents enroute to, nor at, the Air Port of Embarkation. You will not discuss this movement except as may be necessary in the transaction of official business.
4. You will use APO 9527\*- (followed by the numeral ending of your Shipment Crew Number, referred to in paragraph 1 above), c/o Postmaster, New York, N. Y. Upon arrival at final overseas destination, you will use the mailing address of the troops at that place. Advise your friends and relatives of your permanent APO by forwarding a completed V-Mail WD AGO Form 971; also notify the postal officer of the theatre by forwarding a completed WD AGO Form 204.
5. a. In lieu of subsistence, a flat per diem of seven dollars (\$7.00) is authorized for officers and flight officers for travel, and for periods of temporary duty enroute to final destination, when necessary, in accordance with existing law and regulations. Payment of mileage is not authorized. Per diem will be suspended for such times as the individual is billeted and subsisted, as outlined in W.D. Memo W35-2-42, dated 30 September 1942.
