My apologies to Tom E and you. Sorry, don't know what happened regarding the reply.

B-24HNite-15 FO 42-52578 BUCKET O' BOLTS had call letter Q in 857th BS from between 6 Nov & 6 Dec 44 until 27/28 Feb 45 when it was damaged by fighters and flak and made an emergency landing at Woodbridge. It was repaired there between 28 Feb & 5 Apr 45 and then flew a couple of operations as W in 858th BS. Thereafter its call letter was changed to E and it was RZI on 9 Jul 45.

I believe that LUMBERING LIZ was its original name in 487th BG.
