That is the clue !! There was only 1 survivor, a Cpl. WHITE (no further details).

Nine men were killed and buried in the American Military Cemetery in Cambridge Plot Q Row 1. I don't know the crew positions

except for the Pilot Lt. Cherrington. Here are the names with grave numbers in Row 1 between brackets behind the names :

In bold between brackets : the State from which they originated.
