



### DESCRIPTION OF ACCIDENT

(Brief marrative of servicent. Include statement of responsibility and recommendations for action to prevent repetition)

Lt. Berkoff was on an operational mission to the Continent on the night of 8/9 September 1944 when, at about 2830, the number one engine went out and the number two (2) engine began running rough and fire was noticed around the super-charger.

The crew bailed out and the Pilot was unable to control the sirplene which crashed and was totally destroyed.

The cause of the engine failures is undetermined.

This accident was one hundred (100) percent Material failure.

12 September 1944.

I was Co-Pilot of Aircraft No. 42-52767 on night of 8 September 1944 when we took-off for an operational mission.

After proceding to the southern coast of England, the No. 1 engine went out and soon after, No. 2 engine started running very rough.

Both the Pilot and myself put forth every effort to keep the aircraft on an even keel but found it impossible to do so, therefore since we were rapidly loosing altitude the Pilot sounded the alarm and gave the order to bail-out at approximately 3500 feet.

All crew members, encluding myself, bailed-out in time so that only two members sustained slight injuries whereas the pilot was instantly killed as he evidently kept trying to get the ship under control until all members were out.
